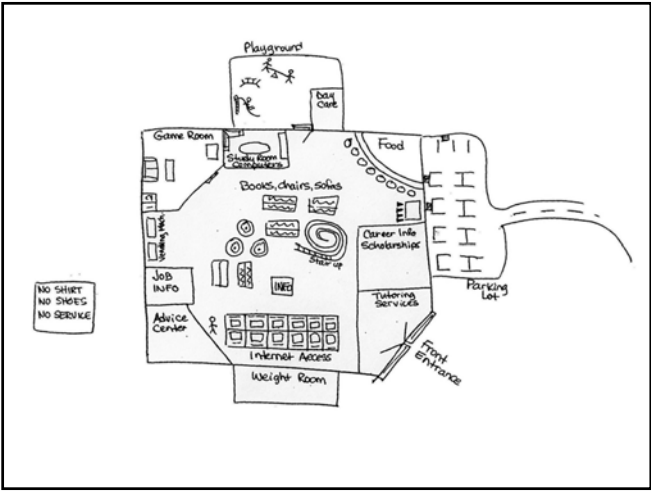
ImaginOn's Vision

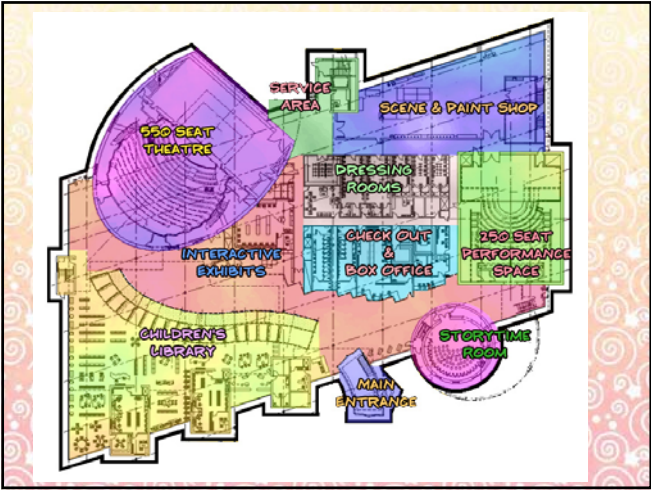

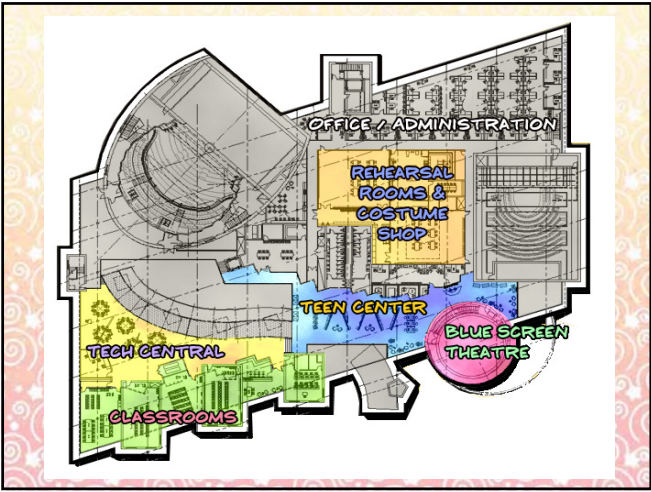


Core Values

- We seek community collaborations that enrich the experiences we create.





























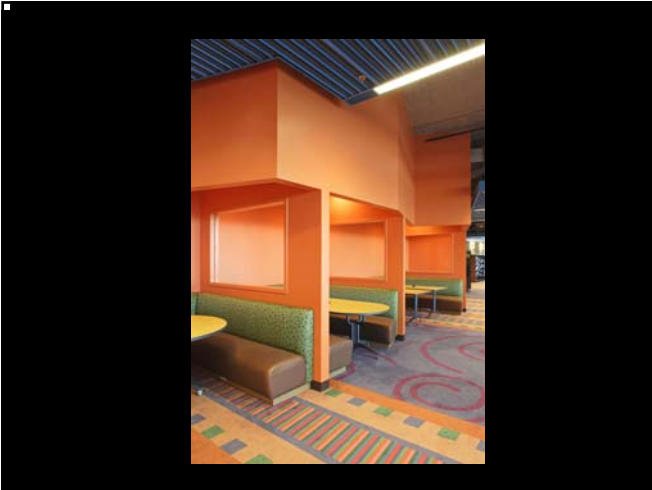


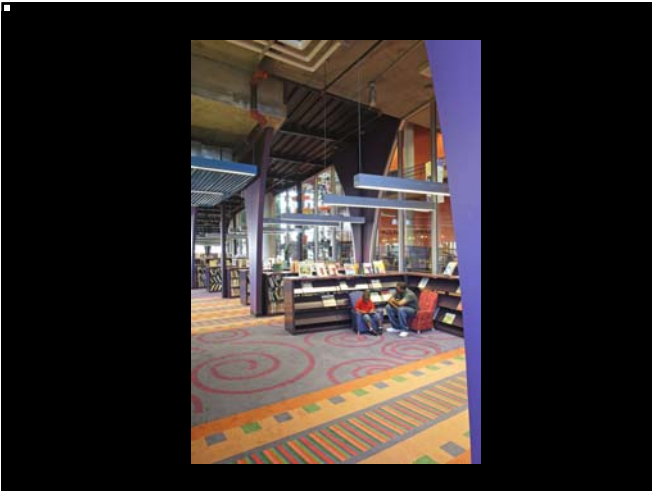




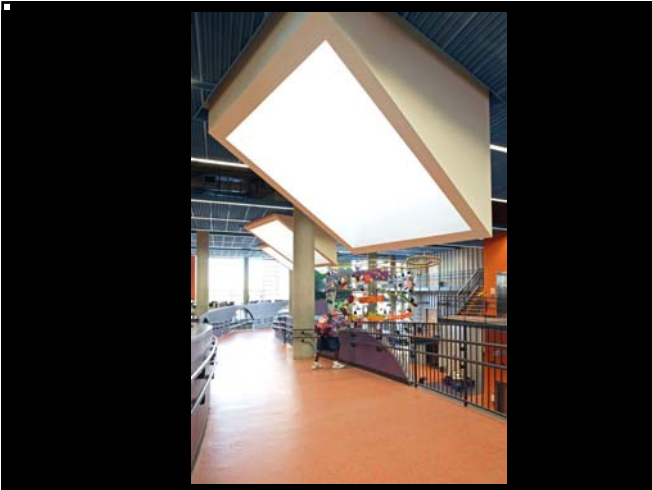


















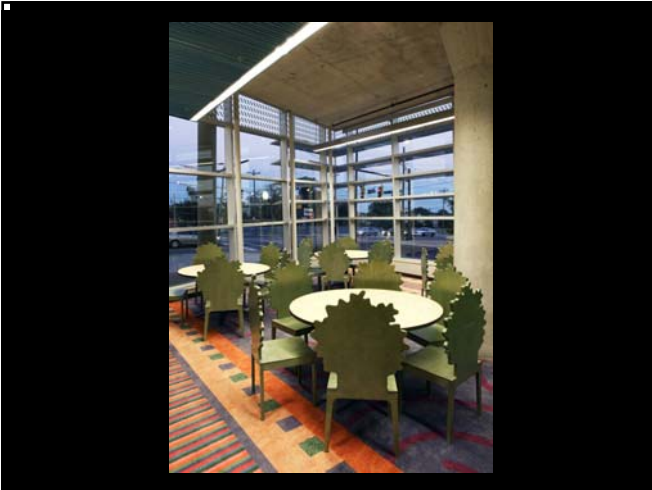












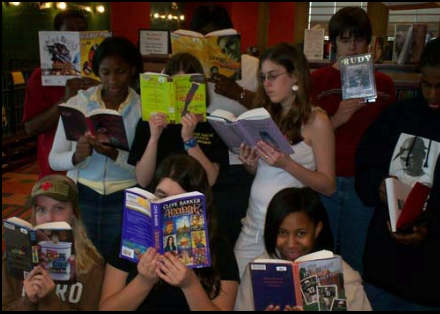


















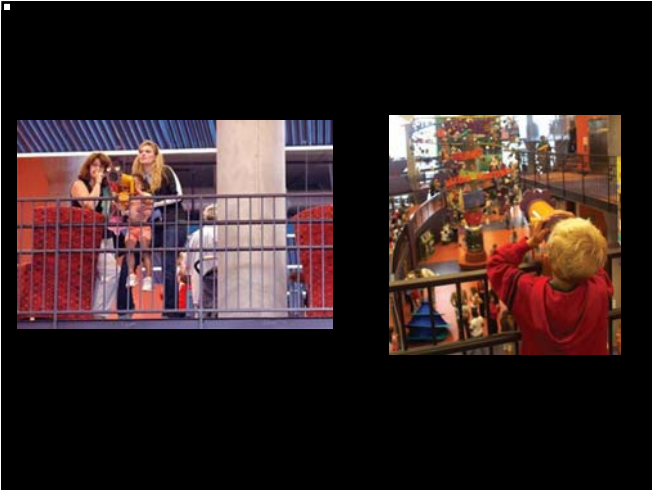
